

7th Grade Recommended Supply List (2017-2018)

General Supplies: pencil, separate eraser, 2 blue or black ink pens, colored pencils or markers (at least 8 different colors), highlighters (at least 4 colors), white board marker, scissors, glue stick, college ruled lined paper, school planner (provided by JMS), textbooks & workbooks (provided by JMS), textbook covers as needed (brown paper grocery bags work fine)

***do not tape book covers to the textbook**

***all general supplies will be used in multiple classes**

Individual Teacher Suggested Materials:

English Language Arts -

- Hagerman/Bauman (Language Arts) - 1 multi-subject spiral notebook with pockets, pack of small post-it's

Mathematics -

- White (Math) - separate spiral notebook, red pen, whiteboard markers
- Hanniff (Math) – 3 ring binder with subject dividers, spiral notebook, ruler, calculator (with square root function)
- Abe (HyperCompact Math) - 3 ring binder (1½ " or larger) with subject dividers, lined paper, graph paper, ruler, personal stapler, personal 3 hole puncher, highlighters, colored pen, scientific calculator (with exponent functions)

Science and Social Studies/History -

- Ludwig (Science) - 1 folder *or* 1 section of a binder
- Hintergardt (Science) - 1 folder & a spiral notebook
- Numark-Thomas (Social Studies) – **separate** 3 ring binder (1½ inch rings or larger) with 5 dividers (Handouts, Notes, Homework/Classwork, Tests/Quizzes, Miscellaneous); separate spiral notebook (3 holed - 70 pgs or more) *All materials can be recycled as long as they are functional
- Decker (Social Studies) – separate spiral notebook

Physical Education -

- Mazzie/Kaay (PE/Health) – athletic shoes with laces

English Language Development (ELD) -

- Salfity (ESL) - separate spiral notebook

Music Department -

- Gelbaum (Band/Chorus) – separate 3 ring binder with clear plastic sheets to hold music

Electives –

- Elective Technology and Life Management Courses – 1 folder or section of a binder & a spiral notebook
- Norman/Kim (Study Skills Elective) – 1 section of a binder & a spiral notebook

7th grade students should not have more than 2 binders unless they have band/chorus, Algebra, or choose to organize their materials using multiple binders. All recommended supplies can fit into the locker. It is suggested that students organize their materials for 2 classes at a time.

Locker → Periods 1 & 2 → Locker → Periods 3 & 4 → Locker → Periods 5 & 6
