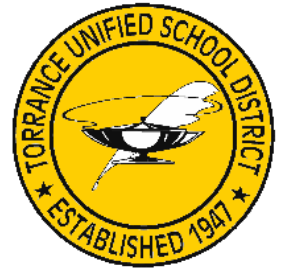




Cabinetry, Millwork, & Woodworking
