


# Patient Care: Sports Medicine

#### **Program Overview**

The Torrance Unified School District Patient Care Pathway provides students with the academic and technical skills needed to be successful in the field of Sports Medicine. Students will learn anatomical and physiological concepts and apply them to prevention, treatment, and rehabilitation of sports injuries, taping and wrapping of injuries, first aid, CPR certification, emergency procedures, nutrition, sports psychology, rehabilitation, therapeutic modalities, and fitness/conditioning/ strength programs.
