

## **Calle Mayor Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Informational Sheet**

Q. Does the school have a website where I can find out about all kinds of cool stuff?

Q. Are there some things that I should make sure my child understands prior to coming to Calle Mayor?

A. Yes, see below:

### **MATH:**

- Multiplication tables
- Place value (rounding to tenths and hundredths place)
- Dividing multi digit numbers (4589 divided by 43)
- Adding and subtracting fractions with different denominators
- \*Math packet, provided to EL schools and on Calle website for download.
- Problem of the Day-worksheet, on Calle website.

### **ENGLISH**

- Read five hours (Summer Book on Website) a week and keep a written journal.

### **HISTORY:**

- Chronology Terms: Decade, Century, Millennium, BC, AD, Chronological

### **SCIENCE:**

- Reading and using a ruler.

### **OTHER:**

- Be able to open a combo lock, there is a video on the Calle website.

Q: Is there a time to come visit the campus before the first day of school, 26 August?

A: Yes, we have OPEN HOUSE (PTSA Fundraiser In-N-Out Burger) on 28 MAY, 5:30PM, Outdoor Music Concert, 31 MAY, 5PM and our Spring Musical, 5-7 JUNE, 7PM.

Q: When is the 6<sup>th</sup> grade registration at Calle Mayor for next year?

A: 13 AUG, 8:30-11:30 and 1:00-3:00.

Q: How does my child attend a REV intervention?

A: Teachers can STAMP a student to attend a REV session. Parents can contact their child's teacher and request that they are seen during a REV session. Students can request a STAMP from their teacher to attend a REV session. Check your child's agenda book, this is what gets stamped for REV.

Q: What is the difference between an OPEN/CLOSED REV session and how do we find this out?

A: An OPEN session is one that any student can attend, class size limits can apply. A CLOSED session is one that requires a STAMP to attend. Usually a CLOSED session occurs during a priority day. The weekly OPEN/CLOSED REV session is emailed to both students and parents each week for the next week on the FRIDAY before.

Q: Are afterschool clubs open to all students?

A: Yes, all students are welcome to attend any of the afterschool clubs, teachers will announce at the beginning of the school year when the clubs will be meeting. **Donate to the Calle PTSA, they provide the funding for all of these afterschool clubs.**

Q: If my child is having difficulty in their class, what do I do?

A: Contact that teacher and set up a meeting, teachers are available to meet before/after school and have a conference period everyday. If you are concerned about an assignment that was turned in or are wondering about a grade that they received, set something up with their teacher, being proactive is always the best approach.

Q: If my child has had or was a victim of a behavioral issue (bullied, not nice action) what do I do or who do I contact?

A: If there was an incident in a class, please contact that teacher. If there is something going on during a break (nutrition, lunch, before/after school) please contact the Assistant Principal, Mr. Ashikawa. Students will need to fill out an Incident Report Sheet, they are available in the Office.
