


# Where do we find out about all the cool classes at Calle Mayor?

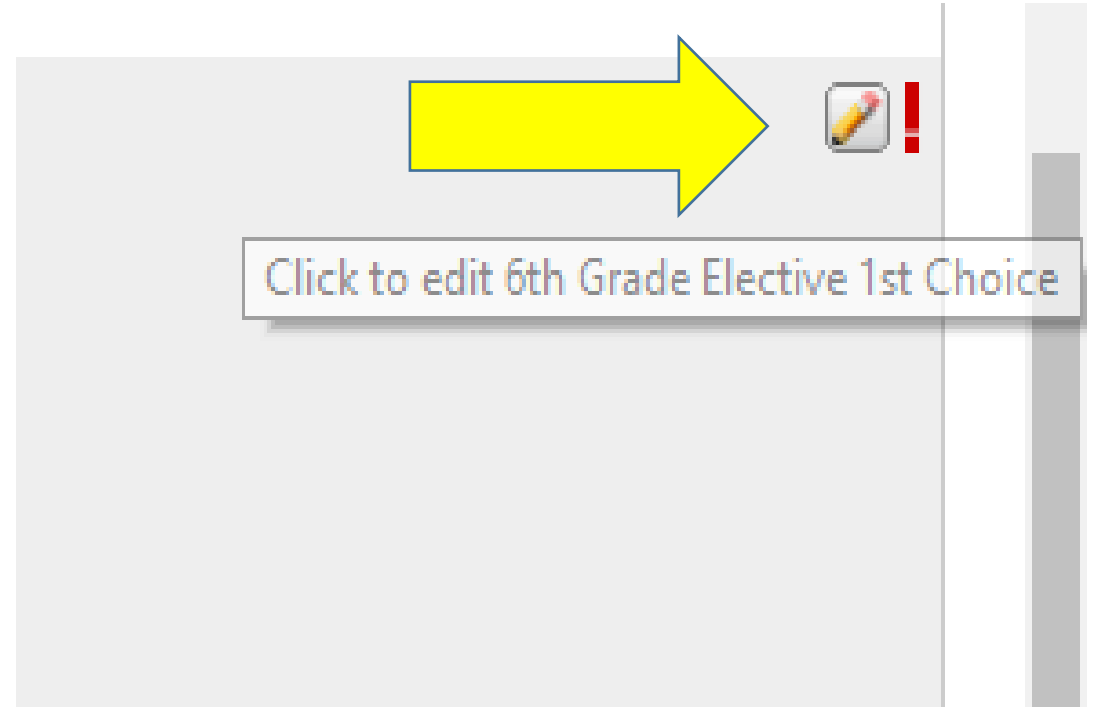

Look for the RED exclamation point with the pencil, these will be the areas that will require you to select a class.

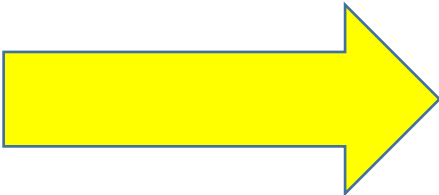
**Click on the PENCIL** and a screen will come up for you to make a selection from.
