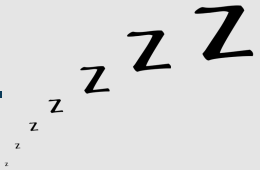

Learn about the physical properties of light by experimenting with lasers, ultraviolet lights, spectrum glasses, an infrared camera, a phosphorescent wall, and more!



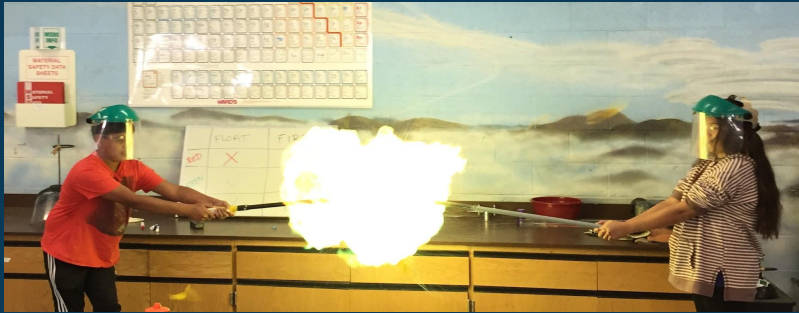
# Atmosphere & Gases

Vacuums & Pressure

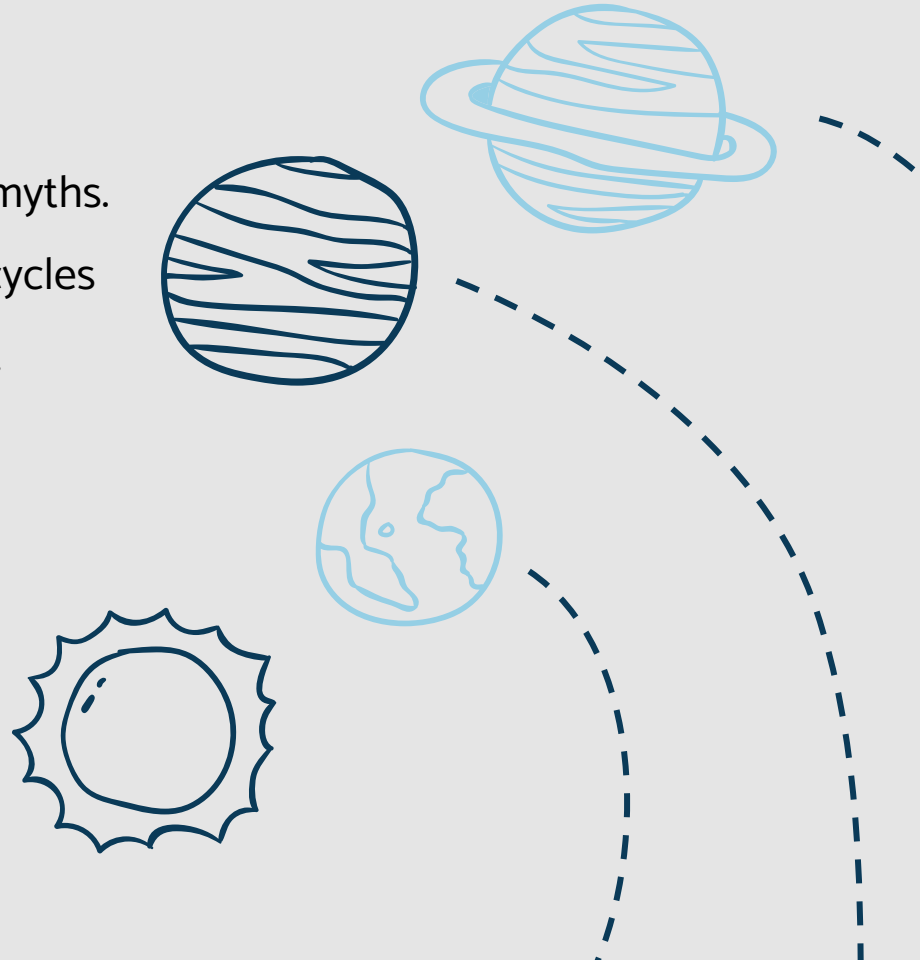


Learn about planetary atmospheric conditions and states of matter. Hands-on experimentation allows students to learn about temperature, pressure, density, and other gas properties.

Explore the properties of electricity and magnetism by experimenting with magnets, static electricity, and electric current in a multitude of hands-on activities.

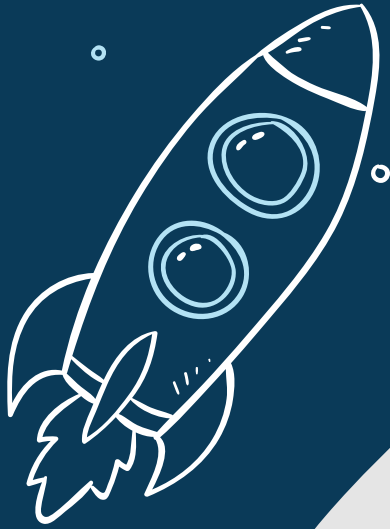


# Rocketry ★

## Zipline

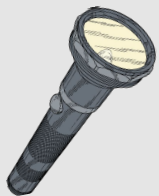
Climb up a cargo net, then zip 700 feet across a meadow

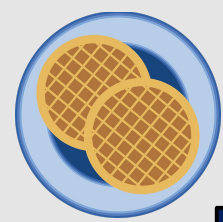
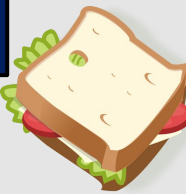

## FAQ

Can they have phones for pictures? Chaperones will take photos and the photos will be shared to research groups after. Students are welcome to bring a disposable/digital camera, GoPro, etc.

Can they have their phone as an alarm and to know the time? Chaperones will make sure all students are awake and on time to meals/sessions. Students can wear a watch.

How will I know they arrived safely? Calle will get notified of arrival, then the school will notify parents. On day of return, parents will get notified by the school to pick up child back at Calle.

# Rules & Expectations

- **NO CELL PHONES** or any other electronics
  - It's an unplugged weekend
- Wildlife - do not disturb or try to feed the animals- keep your distance
- Stay on pathways, do not go off trail
- Stay in supervised areas (if you do not/cannot see a chaperone in the area you are at, you need to find one)
- Appropriate language
- No weapons/fireworks/**gum**, etc. (anything not allowed at Calle is not allowed at AstroCamp)
- Leave valuables at home, we are not responsible for lost or stolen items

We are representing Calle Mayor, so please adhere to all rules. Failure to follow AstroCamp and Calle rules will result in consequences once we return and students may be taken out of activities.

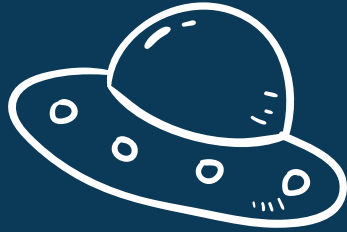
