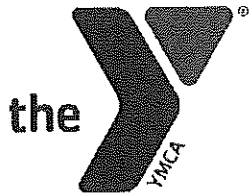
COSTS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

MODEL UNITED NATIONS (MUN)

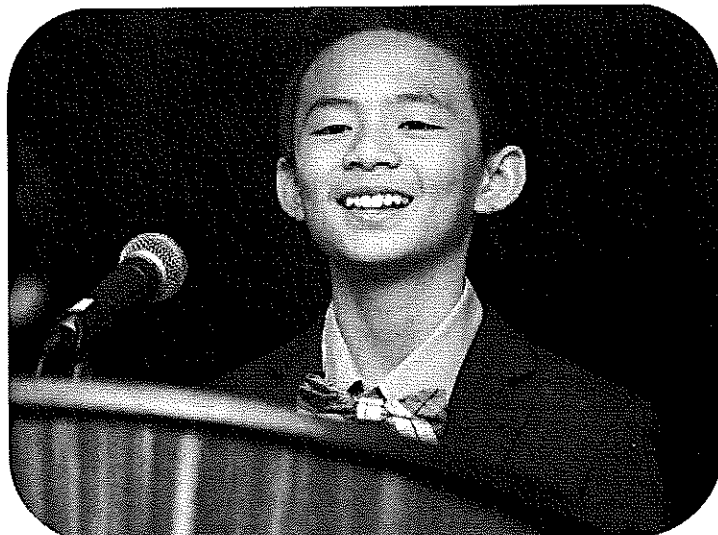
