Did you know that Jefferson is a PBIS School? What is PBIS? PBIS stands for Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports. PBIS is an evidence-based, tiered framework for supporting students' behavioral, academic, social, emotional, and mental health. When implemented with fidelity, PBIS improves social emotional competence, academic success, and school climate. The main

focus is prevention, not punishment. Students are rewarded with jaguar paws for positive behavior and can turn them in for incentives like visiting the Paw Cart every Wednesday, renting out a Nintendo Switch in the library or renting out the gym at lunch! There is something for everyone. Our staff loves to reward our jaguars!
