

Tutorial Logistics

- Teachers share their "Session" focus/topic on Friday of each week.
- Sign-Ups are displayed and up on Friday of each week.
- There are "Closed Sessions" and "Open Sessions"
- "Students selected for a "Closed Session" will be contacted by their teacher and know by Friday that they are in a Closed Session.

Tutorial Logistics cont...

- Students are to record their Tutorial Session Weekly on the grid located in the front of their planner by Wednesday.
- Home Room Teachers are to conduct
 Wednesday Tutorial Planner Checks weekly.
- If a student is not selected for a "Closed Session" they are to sign up for an "Open Session" and be in a room seated on Thursday by the time the Tutorial Session bell rings.

What is a closed session?

A closed session is...

- -A laser focused and intensive time for re-learning, studying a skill, or extending your learning. 10 -12 students
- This session both assists with mastery of content and to move students beyond to higher learning skills.
- A closed session requires a stamp from the teacher.
- This Session is mandatory
- Closed Sessions are based, and run by which Department has the "Priority A or B schedule for the week.
- Subject "A" has priority if a student gets two stamps. Ex. Week 1 : English (A) / Science (B) Week 2. Math (A) / Social Studies (B) Week 3: Social Studies (A) / Math (B) Week 4: Science (A) / English (B)

What is an open session?

A open session is...


- -Allows for help by the teacher is a larger group and more independent time.
- **Does not** require a stamp BUT does require to be written in the student's planner on the Tutorial grid.
- This time is used to enhance skills, improve the skills, review of concepts, reteach time, time to work in groups and/or on projects.
- 20 -25 student capacity
- Students are to come prepared with proper materials, books and ready to learn!

Million Word Campaign

What is Million Word Campaign?



- Is located in the school library
- An option for students to work on meeting the MWC goals and silently read
- Students come prepared with their SSR book or books to quietly read and complete reading logs.
- 25-30 Student capacity



What is Study Hall?

Study Hall is...

- This is an option ONLY to be used as a last resort.
- EVERY student should sign-up or be placed in an Open or Closed session for learning.
- Study Hall is located in the Cafeteria and sometimes in the Patio area.
- Students must be QUIET during Study Hall
- All students in Study Hall must be working on class work, homework, a class project, or studying.
- Students not working and/or talking will be given a detention.
- Students are to come prepared with proper materials, books and ready to work quietly.
