Adding Schools to your “Colleges I’m Applying to List”

1. Click on the “Colleges” tab
2. Click on “Colleges I’m Applying To”
3. Click “+” to add colleges you’re applying to (include UCs/CSUs as well)
4. Search for the colleges you are applying to under “Which Colleges are you Applying to”
Note: DO NOT add a school based on a specific major. Just click on the regular name of the college/university
5. Under “App Type” select which type of deadline you have (early, regular, etc.)
6. Indicate if you’re applying via Common App or the school’s individual application
7. Click “Add Application” after you update your list
Note: Do NOT Click on “Add and Request Transcript”
8. Naviance will ask if you would like the college to communicate with you, this is up to you.

Filling out your Senior Brag Sheet

1. Click on the “About Me” tab at the top of the page
2. Click on “Surveys from your School”
3. Click on “South High Brag Sheet”

Filling out your Senior Brag Sheet!

- **This is essential for your Letters of Recommendation (Teachers & Counselors)**
 - It should be filled out **BEFORE** you ask for a recommendation
 - UC's and Cal States DO NOT require letters of recommendation!


Filling out your Brag Sheet

- **Never Assume Teachers/Counselors know/remember everything. Be descriptive.**
 - *They see, on average, 100 students a day. It's hard to keep track of details!*
- **This is your one chance to talk (Brag) about yourself... take advantage!**
- **Example Question:** What Academic subject interests you and why?
 - **Answer:** English *(Uhm..... That's it?)*
 - **BETTER Answer:** English, because I have worked so hard to master the concepts of researching and writing. What I once loathed, I now know I will use in college, AND my future Career as a Photojournalist for National Geographic.
- **Counselors & Teachers may ask you their own questions** in addition to what is on your brag sheet to get a better picture of you. Be open and receptive ⇒

How to Request Letters of Recommendation from your Counselor

- These are **not required** for Community Colleges or CSU/UC
- Check on Common App to see if you need a Counselor Recommendation Letter (typically for private and some out of state schools)

Recommendations:

- 
- School Report Required
 - Counselor Recommendation Required
 - Mid Year Report Required
 - Final Report Required
 - Teacher Evaluation(s): 0 Required, 1 Optional
 - Other Evaluation(s): Not Applicable

- Complete your Brag Sheet on Naviance
- Email or visit your counselor to request a Letter of Recommendation and tell them when your earliest application is due

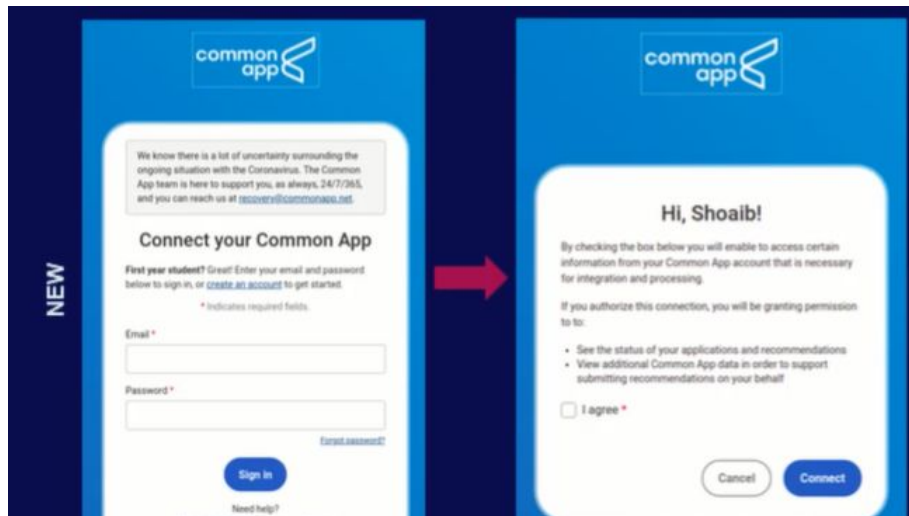

Application for Fall 2022 opens in October

If you plan to attend El Camino after High School, follow these steps:

1. Complete Application Online (wait for Student ID#)
2. Complete Orientation (Online)
3. Complete Educational Plan, "Ed-Plan"
 - a. Meet with El Camino Counselor (Will be doing virtual one on one appointments in October, sign up on Naviance)

**The process is nearly identical for other Community Colleges.*
