

AP Biology 2019-20 Summer Assignment – Mrs. Cortina – West High School

1. Enroll in the AP Biology course page on eTUSD. The enrollment code is ATP.
2. Send me an email (cortina.ann@tusd.org). Include your name (the name by which you would like to be called in class). Check this email during the summer for updates and feedback on the summer assignment.
3. Access the on-line textbook by linking to the website: <http://www.highschool.bfwpub.com/launchpad/poll1e/5790925> and following the directions. **Before doing this, you will need to email me (see previous item) to request an access code*.**
4. Check the summer assignment calendar on eTUSD and complete assignments by the due dates. Assignment due dates will be staggered throughout the summer. On-line assignments will be closed after the due date. No late assignments will be accepted.
5. Read and understand Chapters 1-4 in Principles of Life (POL); summer assignments will concern these chapters.
6. Purchase a carbonless lab notebook (you can Google this and compare prices) - required for all lab assignments. **You must have this notebook on the first day of school so that you can use it for our first lab.**
7. Print out and read the AP Biology Course Contract (on eTUSD), Safety Guidelines, and Donation Request.
8. Sign (and have your parents/guardians do the same) the Student/Parent Acknowledgement form and bring it to class on the first day of school.

*Do NOT request an access code unless you are 100% sure you will enroll in and take AP Biology in 2019. We are required to pay the textbook publisher for each access code (it is the same thing as purchasing a textbook). If you forfeit an access code, because you request it before you are sure about taking AP Biology, you may be required to reimburse its cost.
