ELIGIBILITY: ACTIVITY, ATHLETIC, AND FINE ARTS

- A. To be eligible for activity participation at West, a student must, as a minimum requirement (Education Code 35160.5):
 - 1. Have passed and earned a 2.0 grade point average in the equivalent of 20 semester credits of new work in the preceding quarter (five of these semester credits may be from SCROC if the student is enrolled for the morning session);
 - 2. May not receive more than one U in citizenship in all classes in the preceding quarter.
 - 3. May only use one PE class to determine 2.0 G.P.A.
 - 4. Must follow CIF blue book regulations for academic eligibility.
 - 5. Athletes may be removed from 6th period athletics when they have been ineligible two consecutive quarters.

Students who are ineligible

Students who are ineligible will not participate in activities, co-curricular activity, extracurricular activity, games, performances, and other activities deemed by the academic program, department and/or teacher.

- B. *Extracurricular activities* are not part of the regular school curriculum, are not graded, do not offer credit, do not take place during classroom time, and have all of the following characteristics:
 - 1.) The program is supervised or financed by the school district.
 - 2.) Students participating in the program represent the school district.
 - 3.) Students exercise some degree of freedom in the selection, planning or control of the program.
 - 4.) The program includes both preparation for performance and performance before an audience or spectators.
- B. *Co-curricular activities* are programs that may be associated with the curriculum in a regular classroom. (Education Code 35160.5)
- C. An *activity* is not an extracurricular or co-curricular activity if either of the following conditions applies: (Education Code 35160.5)
 - 1.) It is a teacher-graded or required program or activity for a course which satisfies the entrance requirements for admission to the California State University or the University of California.
 - 2.) It is a program that has as its primary goal the improvement of academic or educational achievement of students.

D. Academic Eligibility Determination:

- 1.) **First quarter** eligibility will be determined by the semester grades received on the previous year's June report card.
- 2.) **Second quarter** eligibility will be determined by quarter grades received on the November report card.
- 3.) **Third quarter** eligibility will be determined by the semester grades received on the Winter (January/February) report card.
- 4.) **Fourth quarter** eligibility will be determined by the quarter grades received on the Spring (March/April) report card. The quarter grades that determine academic eligibility will become effective on the Monday following the mailing of the grade report.
