LANGUAGE ARTS CENTER LABS M-Th 8:30a-12:30p - Hamilton Room 10

For Adult Basic Education (ABE), High School English Language Arts, HSE Reading & Writing exam preparation.

- Labs are an open environment where students can learn English language arts skills from nonreader level to competency-based diploma courses.
- ABE program is a literacy program that provides students with essential reading, writing, speaking, listening, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills.
- High school English courses may be taken in self-paced / independent study labs OR in our new Direct Instruction English Fundamentals courses.

LEARNING CENTER M-Th 8:30a-12:30p, Hamilton Room 10

For Adult Secondary Education (ASE), High School Diploma & Enrichment Courses, HSE Math exam preparation.

- Provides direct instruction courses General Basic Math, Algebra, & HSE Math Prep.
- Offers online self-paced independent learning for all high school credit courses.
- Students may enroll in classes required for diploma, enrichment, and/or HSE prep.
- A credentialed teacher and staff are available for all students who need assistance.
- The Learning Center has a 6-hour per week mandatory attendance requirement.

ENGLISH 1A M-Th 9a-12:30p, Hamilton Room 11

Students can earn High School English credits and improve English Language Arts skills in order to pass the HSE English Language Arts Reading & Writing Exams.

- Build on sequential development and integration of communication skills in 4 major areas: Reading, Writing, Speaking, & Listening.
- Strengthen an increasingly advanced understanding of the structure of language and grammar, and use this knowledge to write literary analyses, professional career documents, poetry, advanced essays, and a focused research project.
- Students will read and comprehend a variety of literature, including drama, literary fiction, poetry, and foundational American documents.
- Students earn up to 5 English credits upon successful completion of coursework.


